Starting Position:	Indian facing OLOD gent behind lady, same footwork throughout unless noted
Intro:	16 counts

1 – 8 Cross rock, Recover, Side Chasse, Weave ¹/₄ turn left

- 1-2 Rock left over right, Recover right
- 3&4 Left to side, Right together, Left to side
- 5-8 Cross right in front of left, Step left to side, Cross right behind left, Step ¹/₄ turn left onto left Now facing LOD in sweetheart position

9-16 Right box with touch, Left lock, Left lock step

- 1-4 Cross right over left, Step back on left, Step right to side, Touch left side of right
- 5-6 Step left forward on left diagonal, Lock right behind left
- 7&8 Step left forward on left diagonal, Lock right behind left, step left forward

17 – 24 Right lock, Right lock step, Gent: Rock step, Shuffle back, Lady: Step ½ turn shuffle forward

- 1-2 Step right forward on right diagonal, Lock left behind right
- 3&4 Step right forward, Lock left behind right, Step right forward
- 5-6 Gent: Rock forward left, Recover right
 Lady: Step forward left ½ turn right onto right
 Keep two hand hold taking left arm over Lady's head
- 7&8 Gent: Shuffle back L-R-L Lady: Shuffle forward L-R-L
- 25 32 Gent: Rock back, Recover, Shuffle forward, Lady: Step ½ turn shuffle forward, Both: 2 x 1/8 Pivot turn
- 1-2 Gent: Rock back right, Recover left Lady: Step forward ½ turn left onto left Keep two hand hold taking left arm over Lady's head
- 3&4 Both: Right shuffle forward R-L-R
- 5-6 Step forward left, Pivot ¹/₈ right onto right
- 7-8 Step forward left, Pivot ¹/₈ right onto right Back into Indian position
